### **Updates since the last AGM:**

- 1. The Canadian Photo Gallery tab on the top of the HOME PAGE leads to a wonderful selection of ACER-CART member-submitted photos of our beautiful county. Submission deadlines have been removed, so as you are out this summer, keep this project in mind. It is our dream to show Canada from shore-to-shore on our HOME PAGE slider.
- 2. Additions to the website are listed in LATEST NEWS on the HOME PAGE. When the maximum of five is reached, the information can still be found in COMMUNICATIONS or ADVOCACY. In time, they will be moved to the NEWS ARCHIEVES.
- "Calls to Action 2021" found in ADVOCACY is the accumulation of letters sent on the behalf of ACER-CART. The most recent Calls to Action for 2022 are currently found in CURRENT NEWS.

- 4. HEALTH SERVICES NEWS has been added in COMMUNICATIONS, Thank you for your submissions to the Health Services Committee.
- 5. The use of other social media has been invested but is on hold for now. Congratulations to Member Organizations who are expanding their social media.
- Website analytics are showing an increase in traffic to our website, and hopefully, that will continue. Thank you to those Members organizations who have shared the promotion banner in their publications. That banner can still be found under MEMBERSHIP in PROMOTION.
- 7. New/Mode is an effective communication platform "that empowers real people and communities in decisions that impact their lives. Our multi-channel advocacy and civic engagement platform helps the world's most important causes activate grassroots support, reach decision-makers, and win campaigns on the issues." (New/Mode website).

ACER-CART utilized this platform following the 2021 AGM for the *Call to Action for the National Seniors' Strategy* with 507 submissions and a 23% conversion rate. It has more recently been used by RTAM with 1591 submissions and a 68% conversion rate.
