

Parliamentary Update May 9, 2022

Important News

The delays that teachers are experiencing in their 2021 tax processing due to Bill C-8 remain a priority for the CTF/FCE and we are finding ways to ensure the passage of the bill as quickly as possible. The latest update on this issue is that CRA is processing tax returns for those who illustrate "financial hardship", for more information see the following CBC article from May 3, 2022: Following complaints, CRA offers reprieve for some teachers with tax refunds stuck in limbo. The article says impacted teachers can contact the CRA at 1-800-959-8281.

Legislatively, Bill C-8 saw significant movement over the last week and is now being debated in the Senate. See more below.
