M-1 2023	BCRTA	That ACER-CART priorities for 2023-24 continue to include the following: a. A continuation of the goal of establishing support mechanisms for seniors to 'age in place' for as long as possible b. Advocacy for public control of and the establishment of national standards for care homes c. A Universal Pharmacare Plan Disposition The Executive dealt with the Pharmacare issue with our New Mode campaign. The " aging in place" is now the top priority for the Health Services and Political Advocacy Committees for the remainder of the year and we would expect advocacy strategies to be developed next fall. The federal government was supposed to provide legislation for a new Long Term Care act with the standards developed by Dr.Sinha's committee. Unfortunately, politics got in the way as the Liberals caved under pressure from the NDP and implemented the Dental Plan and Bill C-64-An Act Respecting Pharmacare
M-3 2022	BCRTA	That ACER-CART monitor any attempts to increase the eligibility age for pension programmes such as OAS and CCP that might impact our members and Canadian seniors in general and advocate as necessary. Disposition The Committee is not aware of any proposed changes to the eligibility age for CPP and OAS. However, it is something we need to monitor.
